SCIENCE WEEK at Kinderland Bonavista 23 to 27 October 2017

It's fun! It's cool! It's awesome! It's Science! This is what the children of K2 at Bonavista experienced during our week long "Science Program". The children had busy hands and busy minds doing different Science activities and experiments where they got to test some Science concepts into action!

Two of the fun Science activities that the children got to do were "Paper Copter" or "Roto-copter" and "Magic of Static Electricity". For "Paper Copter" the K2 children showed how to make a simple "Roto-Copter" by cutting, folding and test flying it. They get to know that a "Roto-Copter" spins as it falls because the air pushes up against the "blades", bending them up just a little. When air pushes upward, on the "slanted blade, some of that thrust becomes sideways, or horizontal push. Cool huh?!

For "Magic of Static Electricity", the children performed some "magic tricks" wherein the children rubbed the pipe with a towel. This rubbing then produced static electricity which made the empty cans, toothpicks inside a glass and some Styrofoam balls covered with aluminum foil move and "dance"! It was true blue "simsalabim, abracadabra!" Science magic tricks which both parents and children enjoyed watching!



Book Week at Kinderland Pulomas

Book week in Kinderland Pulomas is a week of celebrations in which children focused on children's story books and reading. The activities will remind the young children about the fun and importance of books and reading.

During the week, students from Pre Nursery – K2 did performances by popular authors like Dr. Seuss, Marcus Pfister, J.M. Barrier and Eric Carle. The K1 students did a drama 'A cat in a hat' followed by Nursery on the 'Rainbow Fish', K2 students performed 'Peter Pan' and Pre Nursery enacted 'A very hungry caterpillar'.

The K2 children made four short story books based on their own imagination and creativity which allows them to develop their vocabulary through listening, speaking, reading and writing. The theme was my favorite person in the world. Children came up with the titles like 'Sisters', 'Holiday Blast', 'War and Peace' and 'When I grow up, I want to be'. The children created their story as a team and were able to narrate the story with the teacher's help.

We also invited Rivanli, one of the students from a Disable Primary school in east Jakarta. He recently won a Story Telling competition in Jakarta and his performance has inspired all children, teachers and parents of Kinderland Pulomas.
